

MOON SHOT - Thunderlust - The next chapter

There's a saying that the third album is the hardest one.

For Moon Shot, that statement didn't arrive quietly - it arrived with turbulence, routines, open wounds, and clarity.

After the raw force of *The Power*, Moon Shot now stand in a different place. Not at the beginning anymore, but not at the destination either. The honeymoon phase is over. What remains is something more honest: a band shaped by touring, repetition, shared experience and the daily work of staying true to itself. This is Moon Shot as they are now - fully aware of who they are, and comfortable standing exactly there.

The past years have been spent on the road. Club stages, festival crowds, headline tours across Europe. Each show adding confidence, resilience and a deeper sense of identity. Experience has hardened the edges, but also sharpened the sensitivity. Like changing from a denim jacket to leather - familiar, but tougher, more lived-in.

Moon Shot have never chased trends. In their world, 21st century rock is about freedom: the freedom to draw from anywhere, from any era, any influence, and turn it into something personal and real. You can hear echoes of classic rock power, punk urgency and alternative intensity - but never as nostalgia. This is music that breathes in the present tense, written by people who understand that authenticity matters more than relevance.

At the core of the band is a deep belief in connection. Rock music, to Moon Shot, is not just sound - it's energy. A collective experience that binds instinct, emotion and something spiritual together. Live shows are not an extension of the records; they are where the songs become something else entirely. On stage, the music sheds its skin and takes on a second life. You can't fake it. You either step into it fully, or you don't.

Songwriting for the new album reflects that mindset. Riffs, rhythms and chord progressions collide early, forming dialogues between song parts instead of isolated ideas. The process is instinctive, but uncompromising - every stone turned, every possibility tested, until nothing feels forced and nothing feels unfinished. Only then is a song allowed to exist.

Lyrical and emotionally, this new chapter embraces vulnerability without romanticizing it. Courage here isn't about shouting louder - it's about staying sincere. About accepting that fragility and strength come from the same place. About trusting intuition, even when it leads into uncertainty. The songs don't pretend to have answers. They move, they question, they breathe.

If *The Power* was a sledgehammer, the upcoming album is a journey. Heavy, colorful, sometimes disorienting - driven by four people who don't claim to have it all figured out, but who are willing to move forward anyway. It's an album that invites listeners to follow their primary instincts, to feel first and analyze later.

For Moon Shot, success in this era isn't measured in numbers alone. It's found in reactions, in movement among the fans, in nights where energy flows freely between stage and crowd. In moments where a song becomes part of someone else's life.

This is Moon Shot today.
